

## NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN REPORT

A budget allocation was made for 2012/2013 for investigation/starting a Neighbourhood Plan. Tim Fowell attended a course in February and Elaine and I attended a different (free) course last month. Our view is that unless the PC is pro-growth, and quite a significant amount of growth, there is no reason to do a Neighbourhood Plan which would be extremely expensive (estimates banded about vary from £15K - £30K depending on what sort of development you are looking at) and very time consuming (it would take the best part of two years).
