

THOMAS HYLL & OTHER CHARITIES

Are you in “need, hardship or distress”?

... if so, and you are a resident of Great Chesterford, the Trustees of Thomas Hyll and other Charities may be able to assist. A significant part of the annual expendable income available to the Trustees, amounting to about £3,000, is dedicated to paying for Life-line aid-call systems for local residents. Under the constitution of the Charities funding can be provided to meet “need, hardship or distress”. There is no age barrier – all that is necessary is that the applicant is in need or hardship, and that financial assistance would help to meet that need. It may be possible, for example, for the Trustees to make a contribution towards the cost of attending medical appointments or visiting close family members who are in hospital, or to assist with the cost of care in the home when a householder has been in hospital and is not yet fully recovered, or alternatively, to cover financial difficulties arising from bereavement. Each case is considered – in confidence – on its merits subject to the need or hardship considerations.
